

Sunday Time-limits on the Central Waterfront
Implementation Update
July 25, 2012

Project Description

In late August, new Sunday time limits are coming to the Central Waterfront. Free time-limited on-street parking is being installed at the request of neighborhood businesses to help Sunday customers and visitors more easily find a parking space.

Time-limit Description

- New signs will be installed that limit parking on Sundays to 2 hours or 4 hours (see map).
- The parking will still be free on Sundays.
- The Sunday time-limits will be in effect from 10 am to 6 pm.

Implementation Area

- Parking time limits will be installed north of Columbia Street up to Virginia Street, on Alaskan Way, under the Viaduct, and on Western Avenue, including the side streets up to (but not including) First Avenue.

Project Schedule

- Sign manufacture and blockface design are underway
- Notification mailer sent to occupants and property owners week of July 30
- Notification signs will be posted on each block in mid-August to let parkers know the change is coming
- Sign installation begins late August 2012; takes approximately two weeks
- During the first two to three weeks after the change, Parking Enforcement Officers will distribute warning notifications to vehicles to help visitors and neighborhood parkers adjust to the new regulations
